



Senior Faculty Position (Associate or Full) Fall 2019

The University at Buffalo is a research-intensive university and a member of the prestigious American Association of Universities. At the University at Buffalo are the internationally known Research Institute on Addictions and centers in Bioinformatics, and Clinical and Translational Research. As an urban public research university the University at Buffalo (UB) is the largest institution in the State University of New York system and one of two flagship campuses. Through the efforts of our president, provost, and the faculty we are involved in implementing our strategic plan, "Realizing UB 2020."

The School of Social Work (SSW) offers master's degree and two doctoral degrees. Nationally ranked within the top 25 of accredited social work programs we enroll over 500 students and offer the MSW degree, online MSW degree, PhD degree, online DSW, and BA/MSW, JD/MSW, MBA/MSW, MPH/MSW and MSW/PhD combined programs. The MSW and DSW programs have unique and exciting curricula that integrate trauma and human rights perspectives. The Buffalo Center for Social Research (BCSR) is housed within the School of Social Work and provides faculty support in pursuing external funding. The BCSR is also home to the Institute on Trauma and Trauma-Informed Care, Immigrant and Refugee Research Institute, Institute for Sustainable Global Engagement, Institute on Innovative Aging Policy and Practice, as well as the UB/Amrita Social and Behavioral Sciences Research Institute. The successful candidate for this position will have a doctorate in Social Work or a related discipline, MSW preferred, and scholarship expertise in non-profit organizations. Duties include teaching in the school's degree programs, cross-disciplinary collaboration with university colleagues, including the School of Management and other typical faculty responsibilities. Applicants are expected to have a scholarly record appropriate for their substantive area, and for the rank at which they are applying.
