








Accredited Baccalaureate Programs by State as of June 2011




In the past year, four new baccalaureate programs opened and four closed, including two programs that closed at the end of June.


Social Work Programs – Accredited Programs






CSWE Membership – by Category








2010 APM: Gero-Ed Track Numbers


- 70 abstracts submitted to Gero-Ed Track

- Almost 20% of APM participants attended at least one Gero-Ed Track session.












Minority Fellowship Program – SAMHSA Clinical Fellows






Minority Fellowship Program – NIMH Research Fellows








