













Site Visitors Used (% Confirmed by Year)











### Minority Fellowship Program -SAMHSA Clinical




#### Ethnicity of 2010 Clinical MFP Fellows




#### Minority Fellowship Program - NIMH Research




#### Ethnicity of 2010 Research MFP Fellows


