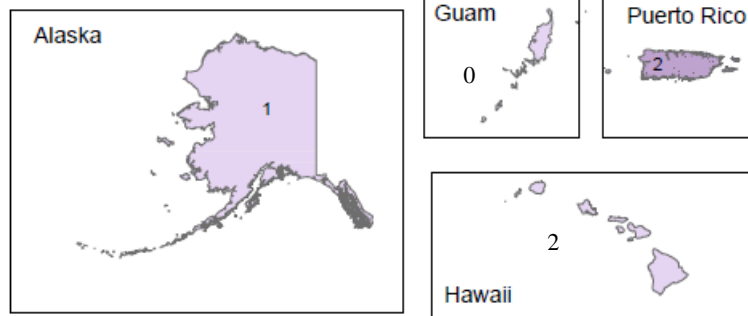
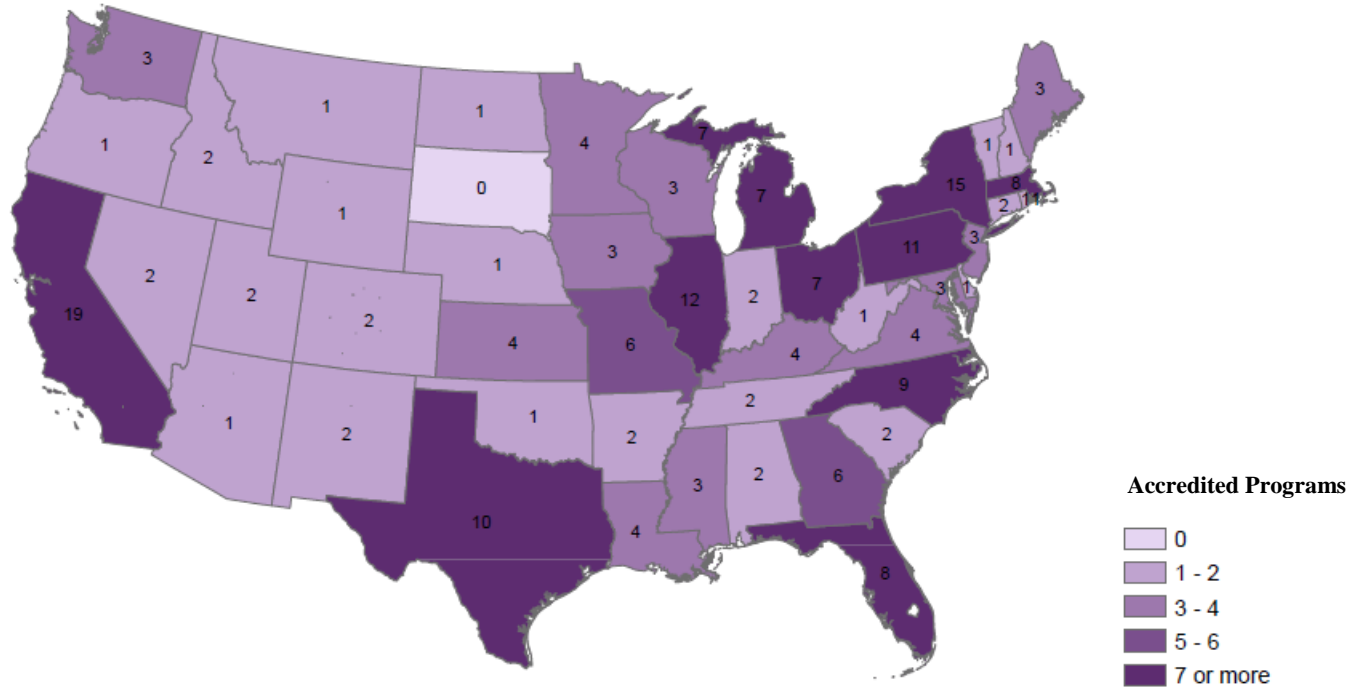
# Accredited Baccalaureate Social Work Programs by State and Territory as of June 2010

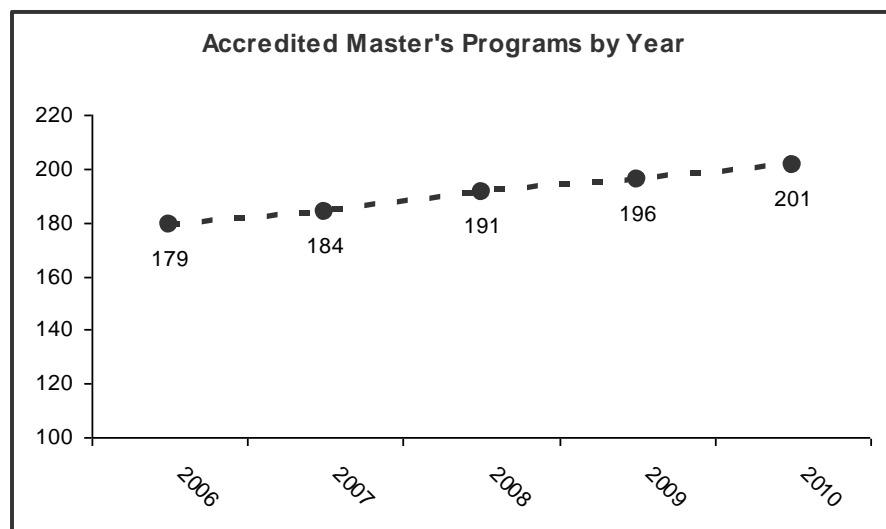

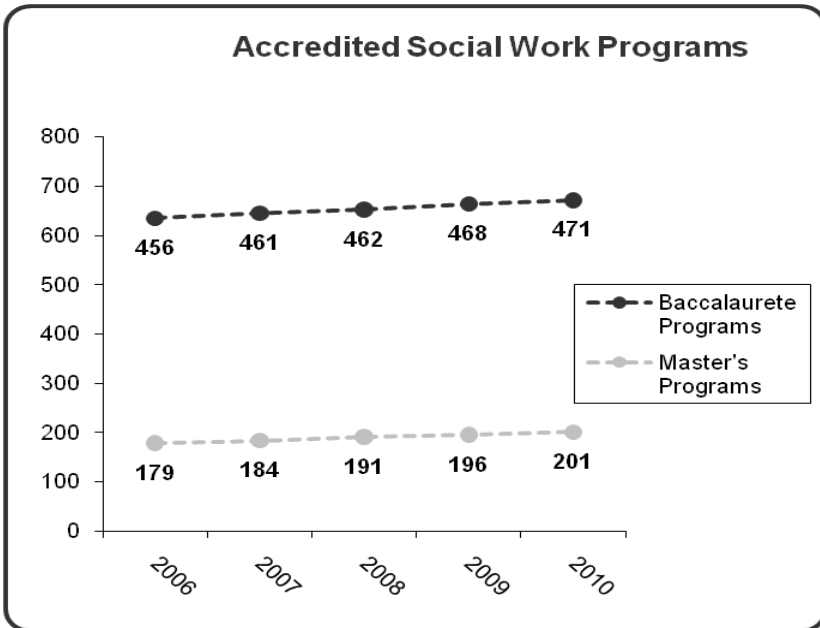

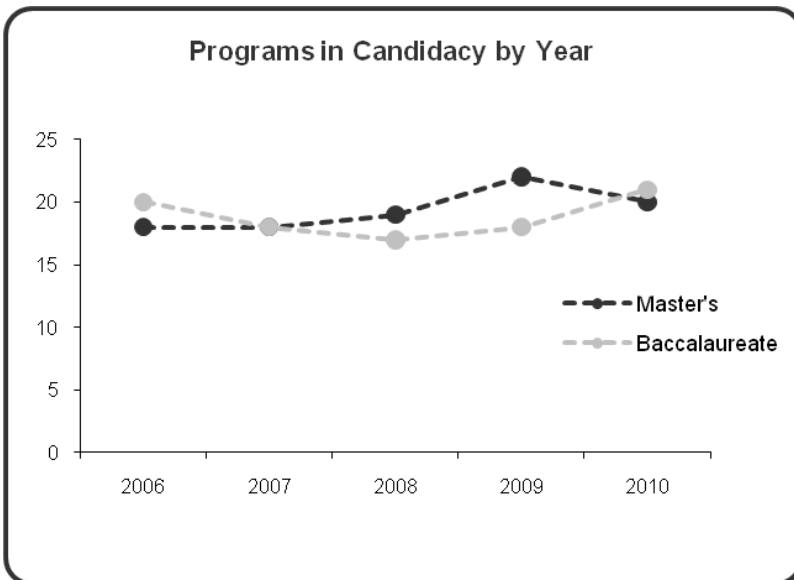

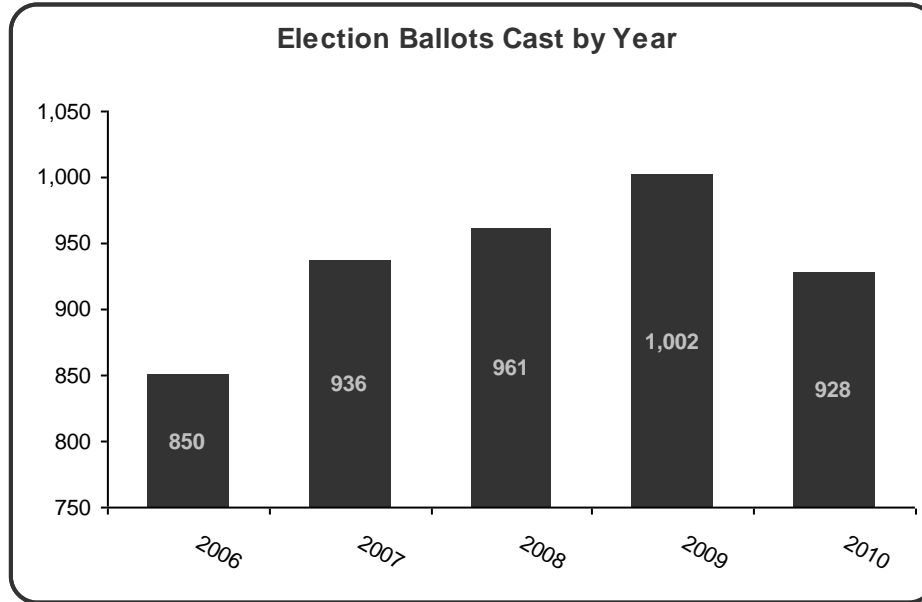

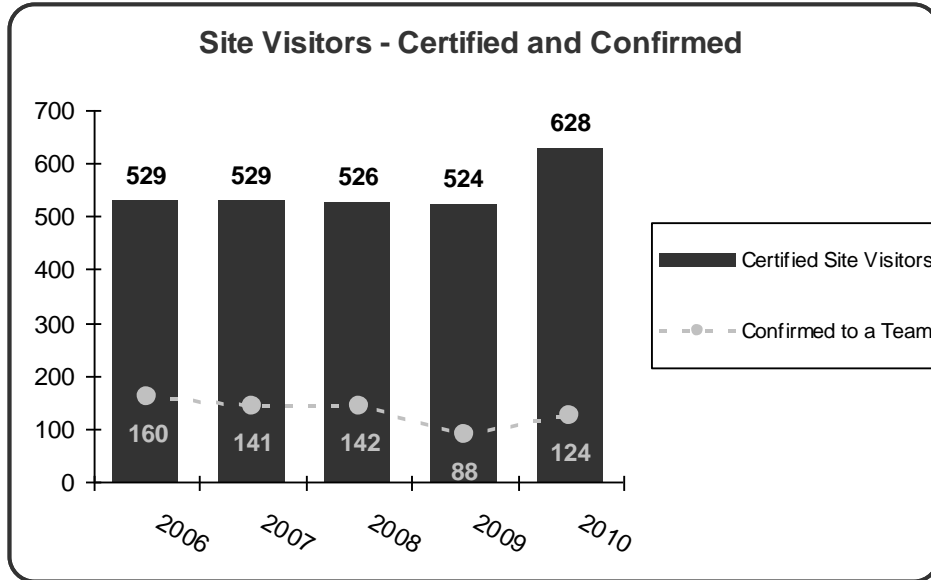

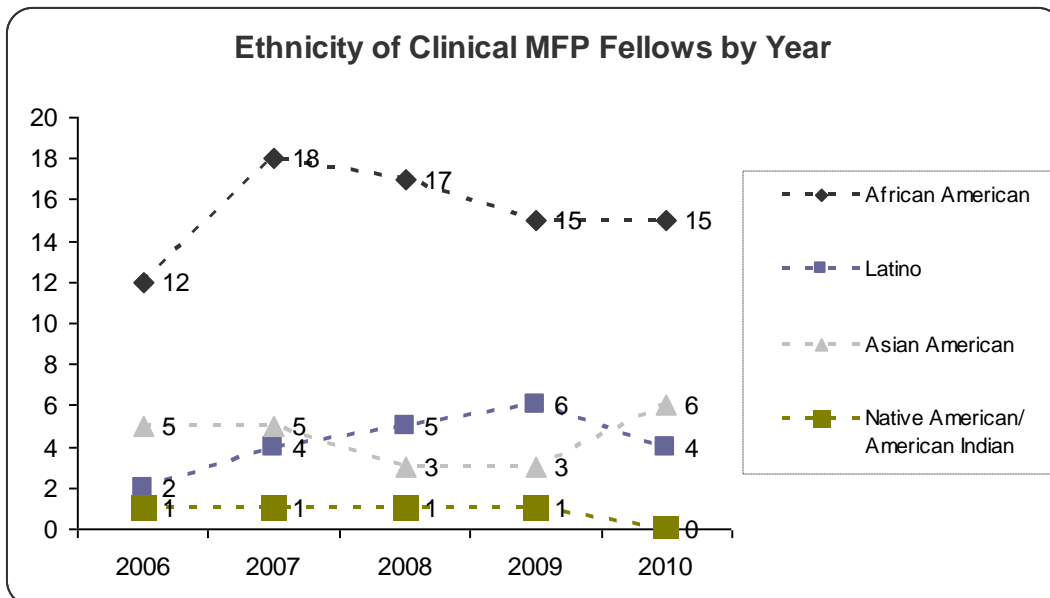

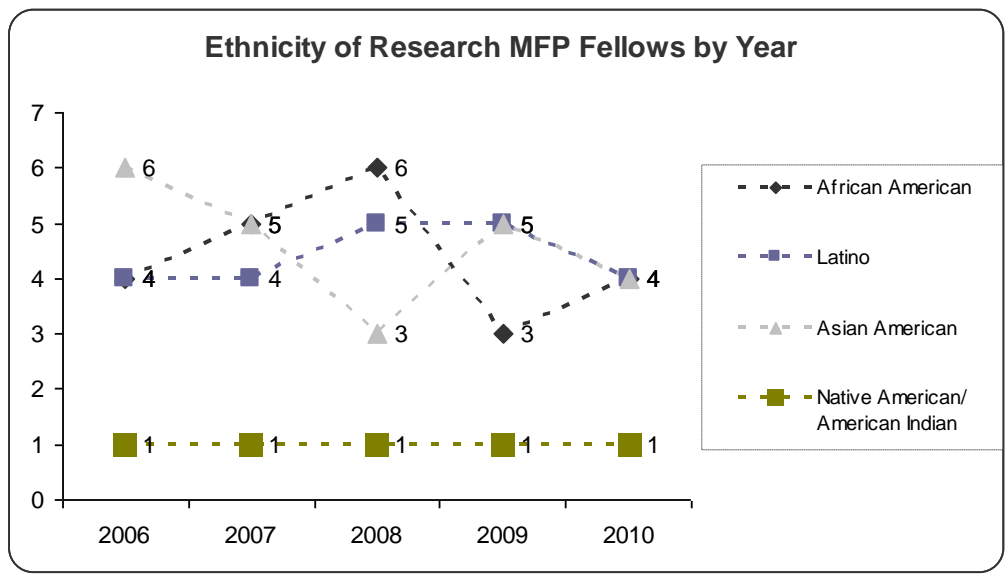

## Ethnicity of 2010 Clinical MFP Fellows

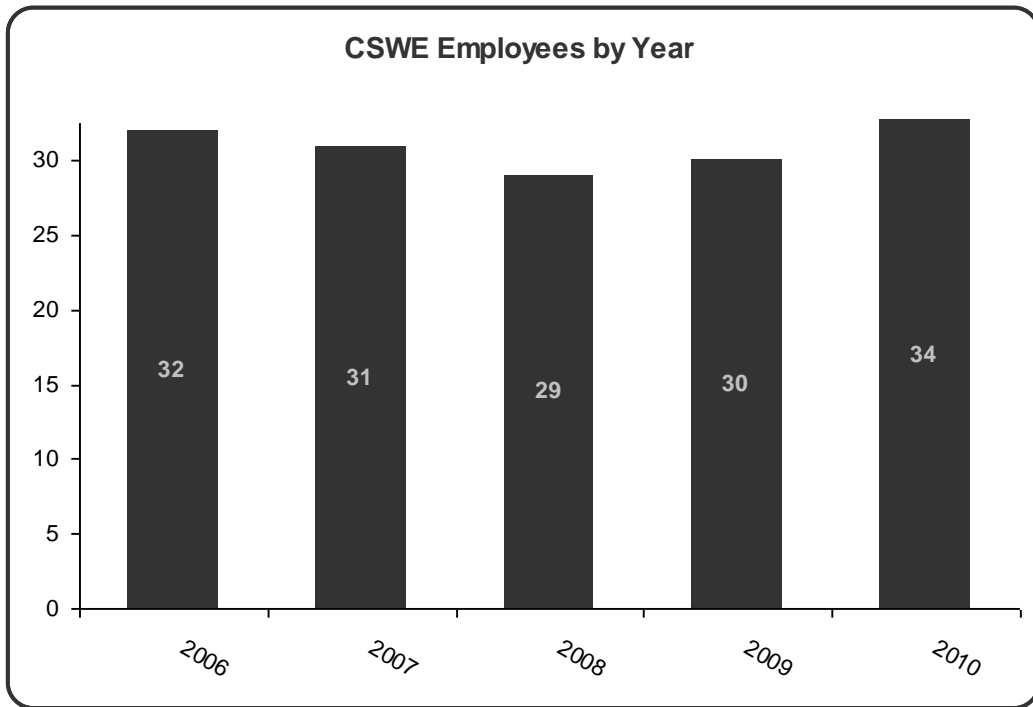

## Ethnicity of 2010 Research MFP Fellows



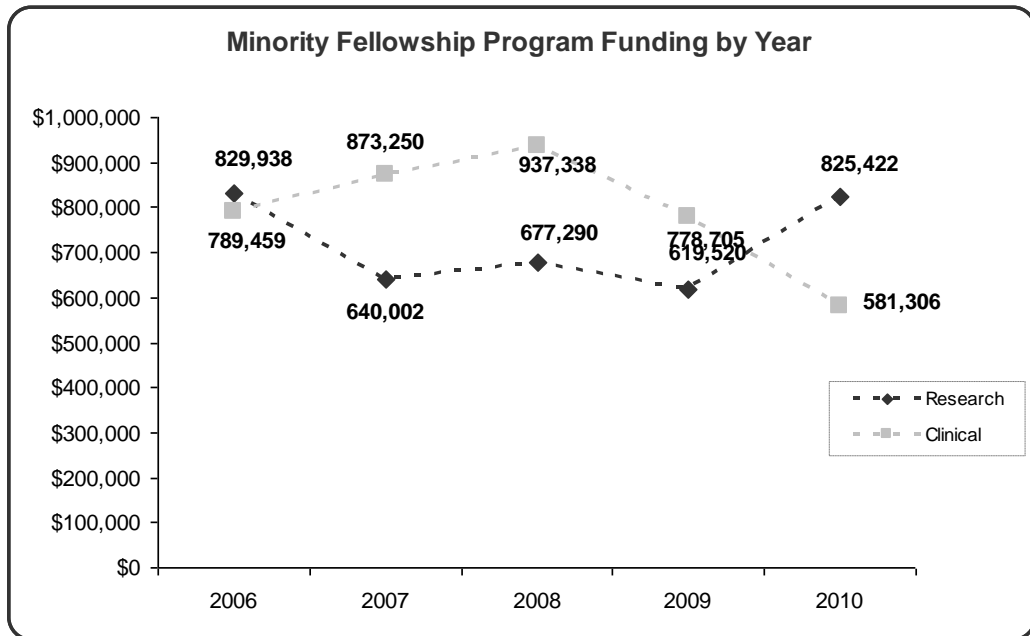
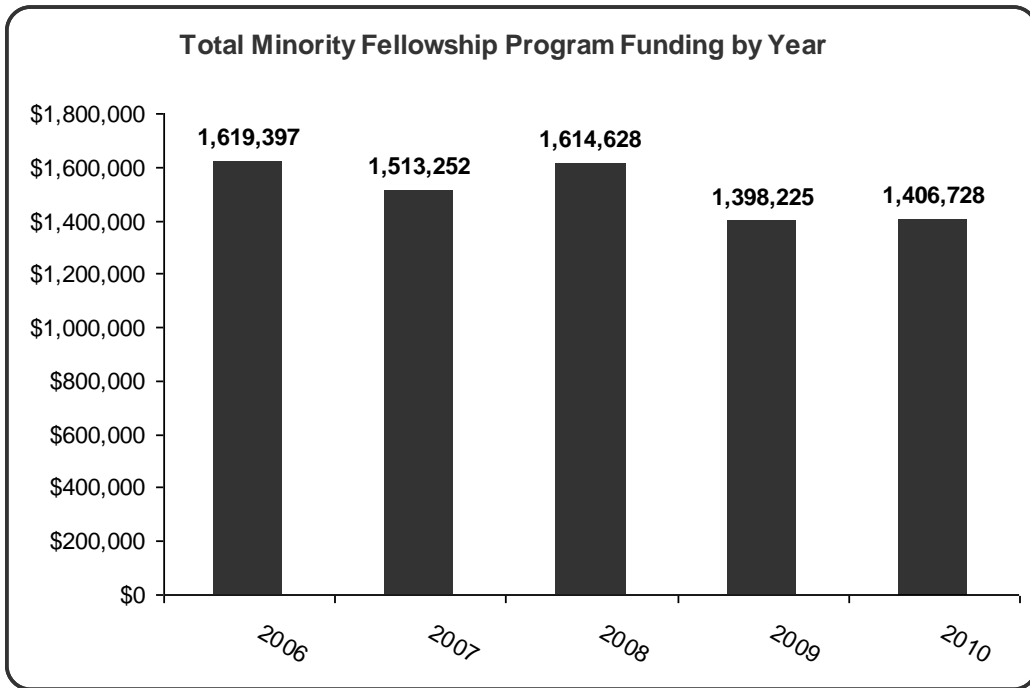

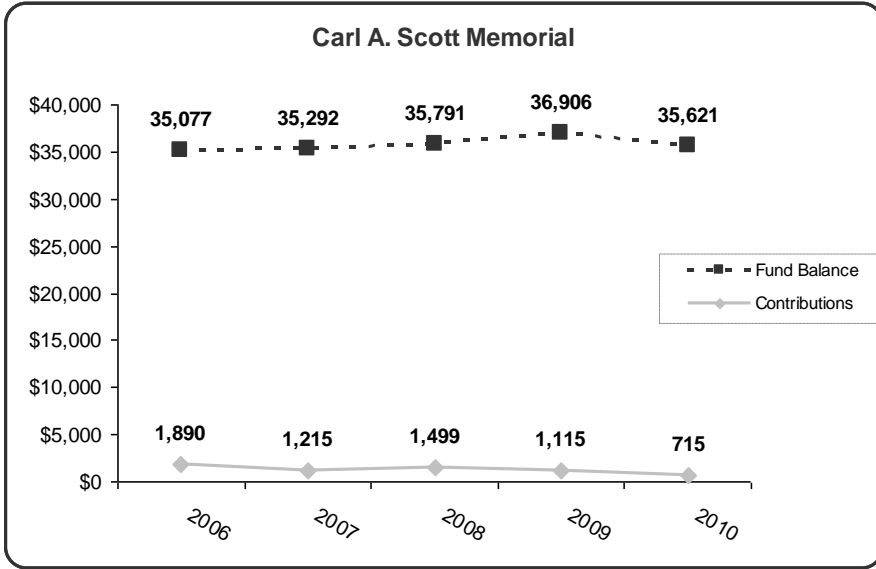

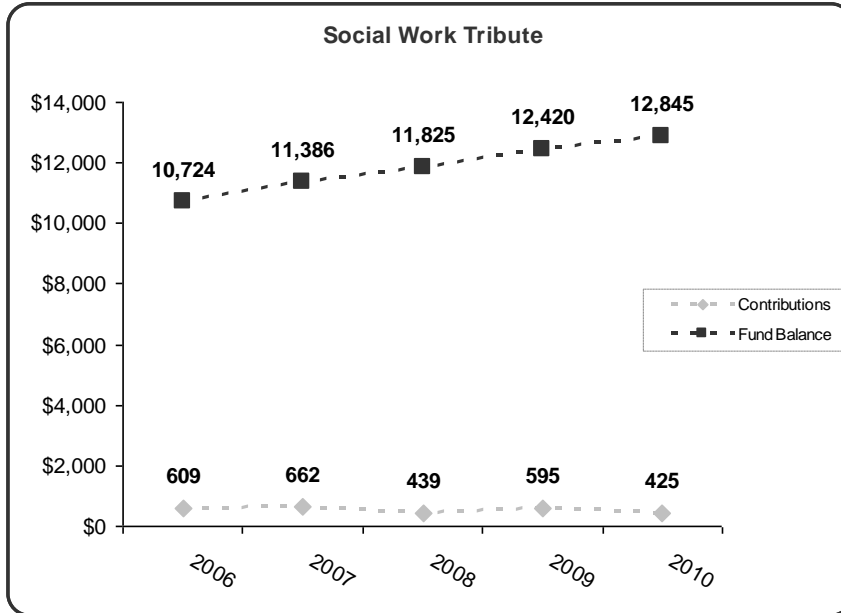

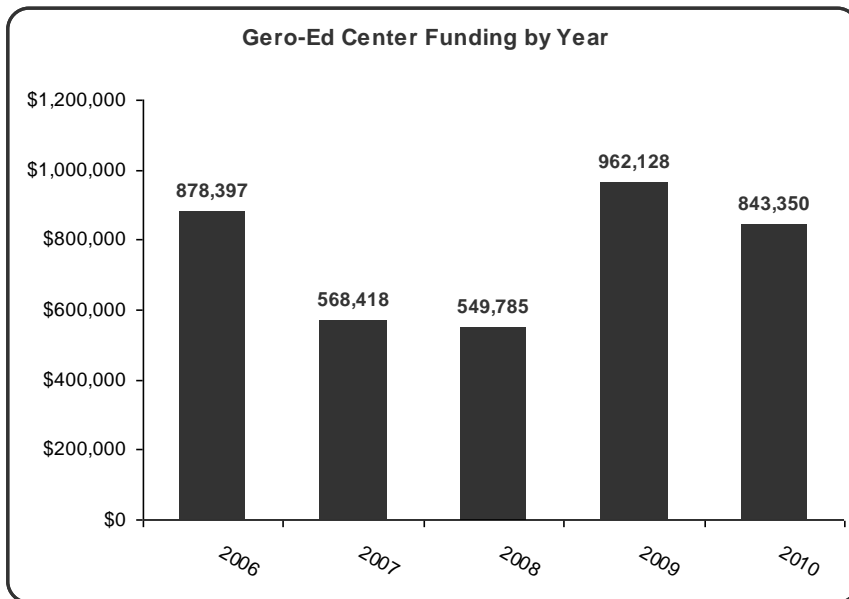
