


Accredited Baccalaureate Programs by State and Territory






Accredited Master's Programs by State and Territory






Social Work Programs - Overall



























Minority Fellowship Program - Clinical


Ethnicity of 2009 Clinical MFP Fellows






Minority Fellowship Program - Research

Ethnicity of 2009 Research MFP Fellows








Last year, one survey was also conducted for IASWR. Institutional Research staff also provides technical support and survey administration for NADD; four surveys were conducted by NADD in that time.


Administration - Employees










Administration - Funding




Contribution Average \$1,423




Contribution Range \$4,916 – 66,421
